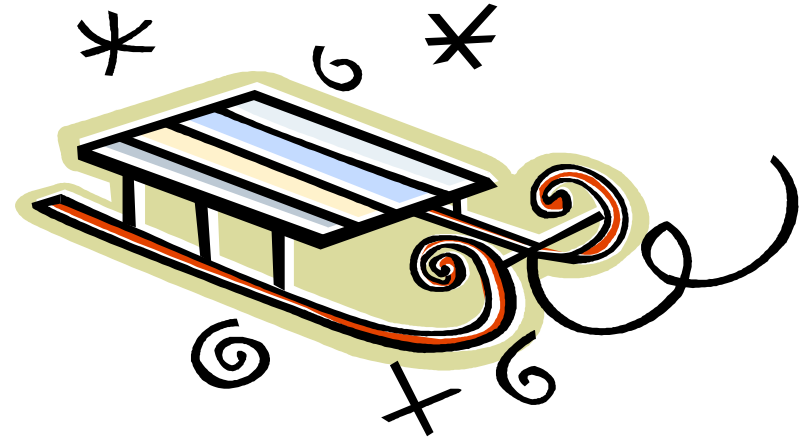

OCFS has specific regulations about giving medication to children in day care settings. The regulations require all child day care programs that choose to administer medication to meet certain conditions including staff who are approved to give medication in a child care setting. Participants are required to take two five- hour courses, pass both days of training and demonstration in order to qualify for certification. OCFS will offer \$100 rebate to participants who complete the program and receive certification. You must register and pay by January 1, 2012 for the January 6 series. Classes: January 6 & 7, 2012 (3-8 and 9-2) -OR- January 20 & 21 (3-8 and 9-2).

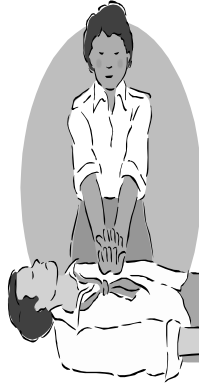
